Application Guidelines

Two students will be selected to each receive \$500 towards a summer arts program.

Eligibility

- Be a student of an Oregon or Clark County (State of Washington) high school or its related equivalent.
- Non-senior student (grades 9th, 10th, and 11th) who are interested in attending a summer arts program.
- Have at least one parent/guardian who is a member of the Chinese American Citizen's Alliance (Portland Lodge).*
- Demonstrated financial need.
- Talent in the fine or performing arts.

Applicants must

- hold a 3.0 or better grade point average.
- be at least 1/4 Chinese.
- include a statement of educational plans/goals in relation to attending the summer camp.
- include sample of work.
- upon receiving the scholarship, must disclose what camp the money will be used towards.
- upon completion of the summer camp, must write 500-1000 words in reflection of their experience.

Specific Submission Requirements

ART

- Please label the back of each photograph or the mount of each slide with the following information: name of applicant, dimensions of piece, medium (oil, pastel, watercolor, etc.)
- Please do not submit originals.
- Design: 5-10 slides or prints of your 2-D and/or 3-D work in a variety of media.
- Painting, Drawing, Printmaking, Sculpture: 5-10 slides or prints of your work
- Photography: 5-10 of your prints (slides are acceptable)
- Video, Digital Media, Electronic Arts: No more than 3 video segments totaling more than 10 minutes on a single DVD.

DANCE

- videocassette or DVD or choreography or performance
- recordings should not exceed 10 minutes in length

DRAMA

- videocassette or DVD of two selections (contrasting is ideal), each no longer than 5 minutes.

MUSIC

- Please label the back of the submission tape/DVD/etc. with the following information: name of applicant, titles/composers of pieces
- Instrumentalists: up to 3 pieces that best demonstrate applicant's abilities and include a variety of styles, periods, or tempi
- Vocalists: up to 3 pieces (piano accompaniment is optional)
- Composers: submit 2-3 scores and, if possible, an audio recording of the works
